Please help put an end to this hundreds of thousands of dollars crime. Pass this along to all appropriate lists for support. Thank you, Rita - CC Oconto County WIGenWeb'

These are the instructions for Netscape users; other mail readers may have different ways to perform this task. If you receive an email from FamilyDiscovery.com, open the message. On your drop-down menu under the heading View, select Headers and then All. Now you will see a great deal more information on the migration path of the message. You can forward the entire message (don't send it as an attachment) from FamilyDiscovery, with the full headers, to:
